FAST for GOOD

Fasting is a physical and spiritual exercise designed to create greater community with God. In a few weeks, we will learn about Moses' fast, the very first fast described in the Bible, and the impact it had on his relationship with God. This year we are enhancing our annual food drive by emphasizing fasting so we grow closer to God while we help others. We are calling it "Fast for Good," because it's about more than just giving food — it's about finding God's heart for those who are in need. Fast for Good has three major components:

Food Drive – We still need to collect non-perishable food items for our pantry. The red 'Feed One' bags are available again this year for you to use, and to hand out to neighbors to involve them in this effort. Bags can be found in the "Live it Out" area of the cafeteria. Return full bags to this area as well.

Fasting and Investing your Time – We all have personal customs that involve food and drink: the coffee drive-thru; the family pizza night; or the after work ice cream treat. Over the next 40 days (now until Palm Sunday) try to 'fast' from your routine(s) and invest that time in your relationship with God: pray for those in need, read His Word to see His heart, and just listen as He leads you.

Fasting and Investing your Dollars – In addition to investing your time in your relationship with God, we ask that you invest your money saved while fasting in our programs designed to help those in need, including the Backpack Food Program for kids, our Fresh Food Voucher Program, and our general benevolence efforts. Pick up a fast food container in the Cafeteria as a great visual reminder and storage container for your investment over the next 40 days. Please return the container on Palm Sunday.
