Medications

If you have any medications you need to bring with you, please contact Jenny Balagna. During check in, you will check them in to Jenny, as well as fill out an information card so we know when you need them. Camp is fun and sometimes it's easy to forget schedules. We will help administer them when you need it!

What To Bring

- Bible, notebook, and pen/pencil
- Clothing for 5 days, plus an outfit or two you can get dirty. Don't forget sleepwear! (Plan on bringing 2 sets of clothing for days 2, 3, and 4)
- Jeans and a lightweight jacket for the possibility of cool evenings
- Appropriate swimwear/cover-up
- Comfortable shoes for walking and sessions and flip flops
- Shoes for getting wet
- Bedding (sheets for a twin bed, a blanket or sleeping bag, and a pillow)
- Towels and washcloths for showering and swimming
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc...)
- Prescription medications (to be handled by your adult leader)
- Sunblock and bug spray
- Camera
- Money for the MIX Station, offering, etc.
- Money for lunch on the way to and from camp, as well as any extra for snacks

What NOT To Bring

- Alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, etc.
- CD players, iPods, TV's, iPads, external speakers, gaming devices, etc.
- Cell phones are allowed, but leave headphones at home
- Refrigerators or air-conditioners

Rules

- Respect others and yourself. No PDA - draw close to God, not your boo.
- No guys in girl's dorms beyond the front lobby and vice versa.
- Alcohol, tobacco, drugs and weapons are absolutely prohibited.
- You must be in your dorm by the designated "In Dorm Time" on the schedule.
