The Way: A Series in the Gospel of John (chapters 1-7) – Season 1 will run from Sunday, September 11 - Sunday, December 7. The schedule for this next series is shown below. Single Moms Group meetings starting September 28 will also be studying John (chapters 1-7) through a Single Moms perspective following the below schedule. Also below is a list of Study Questions. Each week, this same list of Study Questions is to be used as a tool to discuss the below scriptures assigned. We encourage the moms to attend the scheduled Sundays along with Wednesday nights to receive an in depth understanding of the entire study.

The Way Study Guide Questions (Single Moms Group Meetings)

1. This sermon series covering John chapters 1-7 is entitled The Way: A Series in the Gospel of John, (Jesus is The Way). If you attended the Sunday service this past weekend, what were the highlights? What stood out in the message to you?
2. How is Jesus named or identified in this passage? List all the ways.
3. Are you able to relate to how Jesus is identified in this passage? Do you want (have) a relationship with Him, that welcomes how He is identified in this passage, to be a part of your life? Explain.
4. How did Jesus connect or interact with individuals in this passage? How did these interactions change their lives? Have you had or seen similar experiences with Him? If so, how? If not, explain.
5. Based on this week's passage, how does your self-image reflect the way Jesus is identified? Are you able to see yourself being a loved-worthy daughter of the Father as you relate to Jesus in these ways? If yes, how? If no, why?
6. What past experiences and life behaviors are preventing you from accepting Jesus and His identities listed above in your relationship with Him?
7. Based on this passage, what changes can you see occurring in your life to increase your relationship with Jesus? What steps can you take to move forward with these changes?
8. How can you see God working in your family through the above characteristics of Jesus? What role do you plan to take to help your children see Jesus in these ways?
9. Based on this week's passage, how did the individuals in this passage walk (or not walk) in The Way? And, are you or can you see yourself walking in The Way in your community? How can you help others walk in The Way?
10. Based on this week's passage, what stories can you share of individuals here at LifeBridge or in your community that have helped others by walking in The Way?
11. What questions does this passage bring to your mind? What can you do to find answers to your questions?
